



# SAFETY POLICY



Green Piling shall be the leader in Safety, delivering safe products and services for specialist Foundation Industries. All employees shall contribute to this achievement through commitment to Safe working and participation by everyone to a Safety-First Culture.

## General Statement of Intent

Green Piling Ltd regards the promotion of Health and Safety at Work and Environmental Protection as an essential objective for all people who work directly or indirectly for the company.

The Company will do all that is reasonably practicable to prevent personal injury and illness to employees and others not in their employment, and to protect property and the environment from reasonably foreseeable damage/hazards. In particular the Company will take steps to:

- Provide adequate control of the health and safety risks arising from our work activities;
- Consult with our employees on matters affecting their health and safety;
- Provide and maintain safe plant and equipment;
- Ensure safe handling and use of substances;
- Provide information, instruction and supervision for employees;
- Ensure all employees are competent to do their tasks, and to give them adequate training;
- Prevent accidents and cases of work-related ill health;
- Maintain safe and healthy working conditions; and
- Review and revise this policy as necessary at regular annual intervals or more frequently where there is significant change.

The Company regards the promotion of health and safety measures as at least equal to that of any function carried out by employees at all levels. The company shall ensure a continuing programme of Health and Safety Inspections of all the Company's operations to detect and eliminate unsafe practices and conditions, and will endeavour to follow industry best practice. This Policy shall be brought to the attention of all employees.
