Green Piling shall be committed to preserving the environment. All employees shall contribute to this achievement through commitment to sustainable working and an environmental focus.

These policy requirements are met by:

- Minimising waste through efficient use of materials and energy and by adopting the principles of reuse, reduce, recycle;
