

Royal Botanic Gardens – Kew

Details

Green Piling supplied & installed reclaimed steel tubular piles for an new footbridge in Kew Gardens. The works were carried out over a drained lake constructed in the Victorian era. Protection of the surroundings were extremely important. Using steel tubular piling was to help minimise the environmental impact & to help with the end vision of the works. Green Piling had to navigate narrow gates. Soft footpaths and existing services as well as maintaining the historic gardens.
